

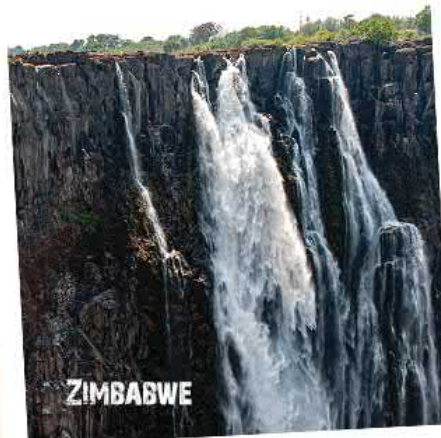

KENYA

Many a traveller's heart has been lost to Kenya. A popular first-time safari destination, Kenya evokes the power and romance of travel with unpretentious ease, and really enters the soul.

It offers magnificent landscapes - from the vast captivating beauty of the Masai Mara. Known for its plentiful game (including the world-famous wildebeest migration), proud cultural traditions, and exceptional hospitality well-tailored for young and old alike - it's easy to see why Kenya manifests such timeless sway.

BEST TIME TO TRAVEL:

Amboseli - Jul to Oct, Lamu Archipelago - Jan to Mar & Aug to Dec. Masai Mara - Jul to Oct.
Nairobi - Jan to Feb & Jul to Dec. Samburu- Jan to Mar & Jul to Sep, Watamu- Jan to Mar & Sep to Dec.

KEY REGIONS

Masai Mara, Mara Conservancies, Samburu, Nairobi, Laikipia, Mombasa & Diani, Amboseli & Chyulu Hills, Tsavo, Rift Valley Lakes, Lamu, Watamu & Malindi.



TANZANIA



Tanzania – iconic and powerful as they are. The vast Serengeti, with the phenomenon of the annual migration of the wildebeest; the Ngorongoro crater, the largest caldera in the world; and the majestic Mount Kilimanjaro – have all long been enormous drawcards to Africa.

The lesser-known parks and reserves in south of the country offer a more remote safari experience; and the diverse range of wildlife encounters extends to the best chimp viewing in Africa in the west of the country

BEST TIME TO TRAVEL:

The Serengeti- Jan to Feb & Jun to Oct, Ngorongoro Crater & North - Jun to Oct, Western Tanzania- Jan to Mar & Jul to Oct, Nyerere & Ruaha NP - Jun to Oct, Spice Island & the Coast - Jan to Feb & Jun to Oct
Zanzibar- Jan & Feb & Jun- Sep.

KEY REGIONS

Northern Circuit- Arusha, Mount Kilimanjaro, Serengeti National Park, Lake Manyara, Ngorongoro Crater, Tarangire National Park, Lake Natron.

Southern Circuit- Ruaha National Park, The Seloud & Nyerere National Park, Katavi National Park, Zanzibar, Mahale Mountains National Park.



MIGRATION OF THE WILDEBEEST

ZANZIBAR

Be it one's 1st or 101st time to Africa, the sight of the continent looming into view as the plane banks is usually an indelible and breath-taking one.

The cultural and historic riches of Zanzibar's capital, the important former trading-post of Stone Town; the endemic rare red colobus monkeys of Jozani forest; the array of water-based activities benefitting from favourable winds and calm seas; its rich marine life; and the range of local culinary delicacies resulting from exotic spices, cultural island fusion and lush vegetation.

BEST TIME TO TRAVEL:

Zanzibar Island - Jun to Oct,

RWANDA

Rwanda has the largest remaining single tract of montane forest anywhere in East and Central Africa and it boasts three national parks, including Volcanoes, home to the mountain gorillas - arguably one of the top animal sighting privileges in the world.

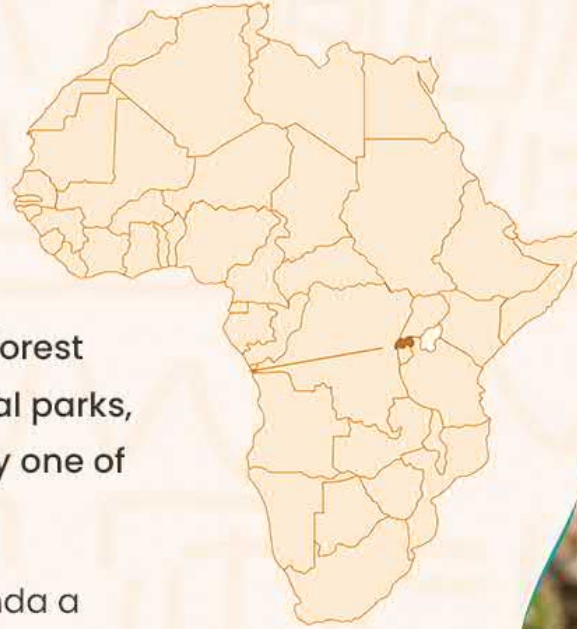
Luxury accommodation and low visitor numbers make Rwanda a compelling option for those seeking an exclusive and exhilarating Africa experience.

BEST TIME TO TRAVEL:

Akagera NP- Jun to Sep, Nyungwe NP- Jun to Sep, Volcanoes NP- Jun to Sep.

KEY REGIONS

Kigali, Nyungwe National Park, Volcanoes National Park, Akagera National Park, Lake Kivu.



KENYA

UGANDA

'The Pearl of Africa', Uganda, shines right in the heart of Africa and in recent years has enjoyed a boom in tourism thanks to its enormously rewarding visitor offering.

A tiny land-landlocked country, its modest size belies so much largesse: the largest freshwater lake in Africa; 12% of the world's bird species; and excellent safari viewing with not just the Big Five, but gorillas and chimpanzees as additional and unique highlights.



BEST TIME TO TRAVEL:

Murchison Falls - Jun to Sep, Queen Elizabeth NP - Jun to Aug, Bwindi Impenetrable Forest - Jan to Feb & Jun to Aug & Dec, Kibale NP & Semliki Wildlife Reserve- Jan & Feb, Jun to Aug, Dec.

KEY REGIONS

Entebbe, Jinja, Murchison Falls National Park, Kibale Forest National Park, Queen Elizabeth National Park, Bwindi Impenetrable Forest National Park, Lake Mburo National Park, Mgahinga National Park, Rwenzori National Park.



SOUTH AFRICA

It positioned at the southern tip of the African continent, is acknowledged as “a world in one country.” It offers a wealth of pristine wilderness, which is complemented by the country’s warm hospitality.

In northeastern South Africa, one will encounter 16 ecosystems and experience the thrill of spotting the Big Five (lion, African elephant, Cape buffalo, leopard, and rhinoceros) at world-renowned private game reserves located by Kruger National Park. The game lodges offer highly professional guides on safari with luxury accommodation, making South Africa the preferred choice for a luxury safari. Off the southwest coast of the country lies Cape Town with its Tempting white-sand beaches.

BEST TIME TO TRAVEL:

Visit South Africa is from May to September. Winter mornings and nights are cold. May and September are wonderful because it is less cold and, especially in September, the wildlife viewing is excellent.

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ZAMBIA

Raw and 'real' Africa, blessed with jaw-dropping scenery and some of the best big game viewing on the continent, Zambia is surprisingly sometimes pitched as a 2nd time safari-goer's destination, behind the more 'iconic' options of the Masai Mara, the Serengeti or the Okavango Delta

With the Victoria Falls, one of the 7 natural wonders of the world, on the southern border, Zambia lends itself to some compelling circuit itineraries, combining excellent wildlife, action & adventure and spectacular landscapes.

BEST TIME TO TRAVEL:

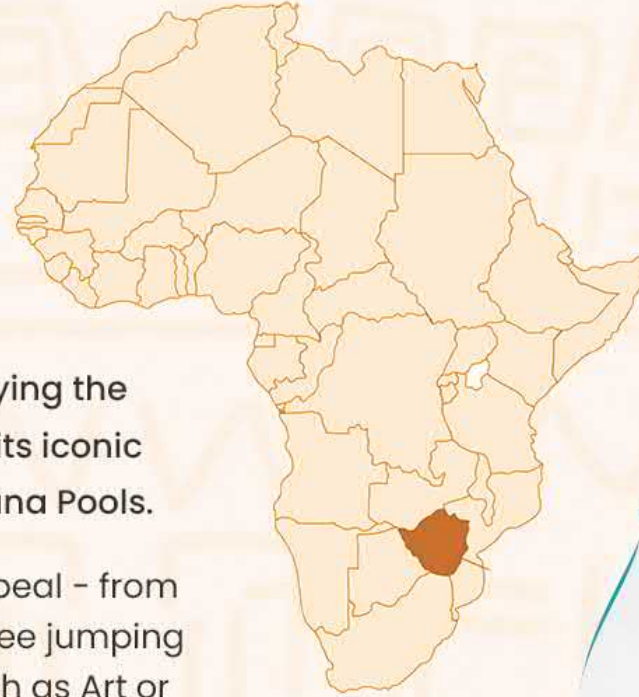
Etosha & Damaraland - Jun to Nov, Skeleton Coast & Kunene River - May to Oct,
The Namib Desert - May to Sep

KEY REGIONS

Lower Zambezi National Park, South Luangwa, Kafue, Livingstone.



ZIMBABWE



Zimbabwe is the stuff of historic travelling legend, typifying the romance of Africa. However it is by no means limited to its iconic highlights of Victoria Falls, Hwange National Park and Mana Pools.

It has correspondingly diverse and sophisticated guest appeal - from high octane adventure such as white water rafting or bungee jumping over the Falls; to more sedate and refined experiences such as Art or Steam Train Safaris.

BEST TIME TO TRAVEL:

April & May, is the end of summer, the weather is still quite hot but the rain is drying up. June to October is the dry season and considered the best for game viewing. Cooler nights and mornings mean a jumper or two should be packed. November to March is the wet season, humidity is high now as are the temperatures often over 30°C during the day.

KEY REGIONS

Victoria Falls, Hwange National Park, Mana Pools, Kariba, Matobo Hills.



BOTSWANA

Botswana is undoubtedly one of Africa's premier safari destinations, with the Okavango Delta an undisputed highlight.

Huge areas are protected as National Parks or Game Reserves and it enjoys a rich variety of wildlife including many species of mammals, birds, reptiles, amphibians and fish. Botswana is one of the oldest continuous democracies in Africa and it is known to be safe and welcoming.

BEST TIME TO TRAVEL:

May to October, Warm sunny days (22°C-35°C) and chilly nights

November to April is the green season

NAMIBIA



Namibia is a landscape of striking contrasts: dramatic coastlines; shifting deserts; majestic canyons; lush, river-fed plains; rugged mountains; and adrenalin-busting ocean waters.

But for all its awe-inspiring natural splendour, Namibia also conveys a compelling human tale: the extant Himba and San tribespeople offer insight to their noble, ancient wisdom; the plentiful shipwrecks which frame the Skeleton Coast speak of lives lost to risk and adventure in bygone days; whilst the uncomfortable history of colonial settlement and oppression is told through the architecture and museums of the towns and cities

BEST TIME TO TRAVEL:

Etosha & Damaraland - Jun to Nov, Skeleton Coast & Kunene River - May to Oct,
The Namib Desert - May to Sep

KEY REGIONS

Windhoek, Swakopmund, Twyfelfontein, Etosha National Park, Sossusvlei, Deadvlei & Sesriem
Damarland, Namib Naukluft National Park, Koakoveld, Caprivi, Fish River Canyon, Skeleton Coast.



MALAWI

Malawi may never have reached iconic, glory status as a destination compared to some of its African neighbours, but its star is rising with a growing appreciation of its unique contribution to Africa travel.

Lake Malawi is Africa's third largest lake, created by a trough formed by the Great Rift Valley - an alluring expanse of glistening crystal-clear water, peppered with idyllic desert islands, perfect for snorkelling, diving and canoeing, or equally lazing shoreside.

BEST TIME TO TRAVEL:

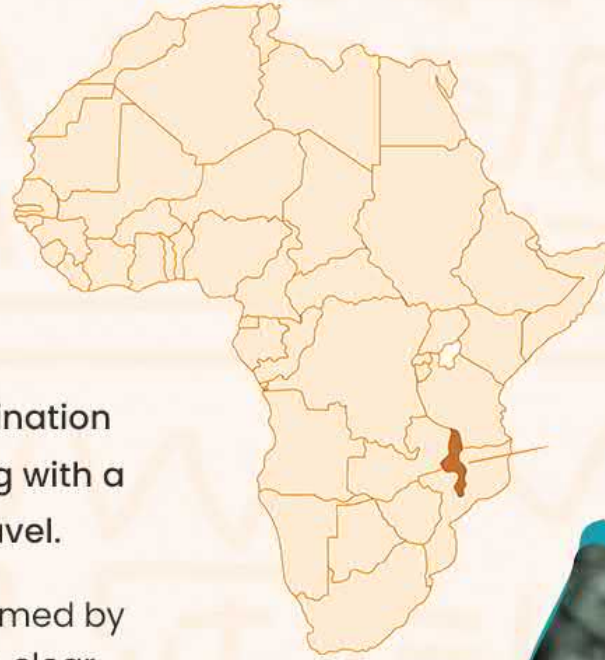
Most of Malawi experiences their heaviest rainfall from October to March with the hottest months being Sept-Oct. The Nyika Plateau experiences cooler year round temps.

KEY REGIONS

THE SOUTH - Blantyre, Mount Mulanje, Zomba Plateau, Likoma Island, Lake Malawi National Park, Liwonde, and Majete Wildlife Reserve

THE CENTRAL - Nkhotakota Wildlife Reserve, NTSCHISI Forest Reserve, Viphya Plateau

THE NORTH - Nyika Plateau, Vwaza March Wildlife Reserve, Lilongwe



MOZAMBIQUE



Mozambique is blessed by geography: 1709 miles of unspoilt glittering Indian Ocean coastline to be precise - where azure seas, powder white sands and remote, pristine islands are sure to evoke one's inner mermaid or merman.

Mozambique is the perfect beach partner. It offers an enticing counterbalance to the drama of safari, with the promise of languid days watching sunlight dance on water. and canoeing, or equally lazing shoreside.

BEST TIME TO TRAVEL:

South Mozambique & Bazaruto - May to Nov. North Mozambique & Quirimbas - May to Nov.

KEY REGIONS

VILANCULOS & BAZARUTO ARCHIPELAGO, ILHA DA MOZAMBIQUE, MAPUTO, INHAMBANE & TOFO, PEMBA & QUIRIMBAS ARCHIPELAGO, GAME RESERVES



MADAGASCAR



A true wildlife-lover's paradise, Madagascar is the world's 4th largest island, situated 400km off the mainland of Africa.

It is a land of astonishing landscapes and rich biodiversity; home to 5% of the earth's species; where an impressive 80% of the country's flora and fauna is endemic. Culturally it is a fascinating mix, with people of Indonesian, Arabic and African descent, and French colonial influences.

BEST TIME TO TRAVEL:

Sub-tropical climate. Two distinct climatic zones - East is wet, West dry, a mix of weather zones on the central plateaux. The Rainy season from November to April, dry season runs from May - October. Jan - March is the cyclone season.

KEY REGIONS

THE EAST - Andasibe-Mantadia National Park, Palmarium Reserve, Masoala National Park, Sainte Marie

THE SOUTH - Isalo National Park, Fort Dauphin

THE NORTH - Nosy Be, Amber Mountain National Park, Anakarana Reserve, Nosy Ankao

THE WEST - Anjajavy Reserve, Tsingy de Bemaraha, Avenue of the Baobabs & Kirindy Reserve
